

Butler Beauty Academy acknowledges its signed and returned to the U.S. Department of Education the Certification and Agreement which gives the assurance that Butler Beauty Academy intends to use the applicable amount of funds designated under the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSAA) (CFDA 84.425Q) ((a) (4) Program) to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.

The institution received a Grant in the amount of \$76,951 from the U.S. Department of Education in January of 2021. This grant is intended for students who have exceptional financial need created by the COVID-19 pandemic. Butler, Kittanning, and New Castle Beauty Academies collectively distributed 128 applications to eligible students. Of the 128 applications that were distributed, 41 were returned to the Academies. \$50,250 was distributed to 30 students who demonstrated an exceptional financial need based on FAFSA information and/or application. Students who were decided to be ineligible showed no exceptional financial need *due* to COVID-19.

These funds must be used to cover expenses related to the disruption of campus operations including eligible expenses under a students' cost of attendance such as food, housing, course materials, technology, health care and childcare.

The method used by the Academies to determine which students receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants and how much they would receive under section 314(c)(3) of the CRRSAA is described as:
